AN ORDINANCE FIXING HOURS FOR THE CARLISLE CITY PARK, TENNIS COURT, COMMUNITY BUILDING AND BASEBALL FIELD IN THE CITY OF CARLISLE, ARKANSAS; PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFORE; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARLISLE, CARLISLE, ARKANSAS;

SECTION I. The hours for the Carlisle City Park shall be 7:00 a.m. till 9:00 p.m., unless special permission has been granted by the Carlisle City Council prior to any event. No person, or organization shall be in the City Park after 9:00 p.m..

SECTION II. The hours for the Carlisle Community Building shall be 7:00 a.m. till 10:00 p.m. Monday thru Thursday, and 7:00 a.m. till 11:00 p.m. Friday and Saturday, and 7:00 a.m. till 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, unless special permission has been granted by the Carlisle City Council prior to any event. No person, or organization shall be in the Community Building after closing hours.

SECTION III. The hours for the Tennis Court shall be 7:00 a.m. till 10:00 p.m., unless special permission has been granted by the Carlisle City Council prior to any event. No person, or organization shall be on the Tennis Court after closing hours.

SECTION 1V. The hours for the Carlisle Baseball Field shall be 7:00 a.m. till 10:00 p.m. or 30 minutes after the last scheduled ball game. No person, or or organization shall be on the Baseball Field after closing hours.

SECTION V. <u>PENALTY</u>: Any person, or organization violating any provision of the Ordinance shall on the first offense be issued a warning ticket. Any person, or organization violating any provision of this ordinance after a warning has been issued shall be fined not less than five dollars (\$5.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$108.00) for each offense.

SECTION VI. <u>REPEAL</u>: This Ordinance repeals all ordinances in conflict herewith.

SECTION VII. EMERGENCY: It is hereby assertained and declared that there is an immediate need, in order to protect the health and safety of the citizens of Carlisle, for the passage of this Ordinance. The ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety and shall take effect and be in force without delay from and after its passage and publication.
